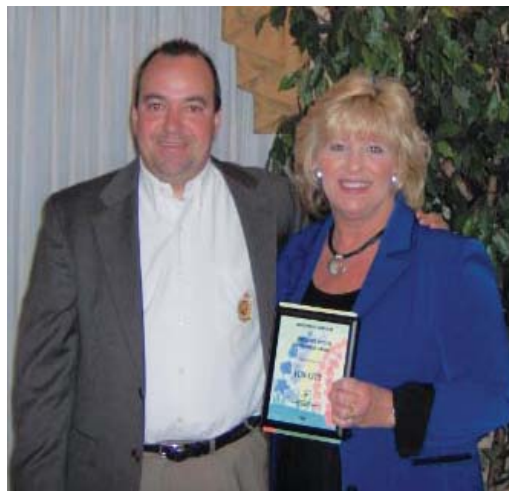
Community Employment Services - Employer Special Recognition Awards
