Pumpkin Bars

1 16oz can pumpkin
 1 cup oil
 2 cups sugar
 4 eggs
Mix well then add dry ingredients
 2 cups flour
 2 tsp baking soda
 ½ tsp salt
 1 tsp cinnamon
 1 cup chopped nuts, optional
 Pour into a greased 15 x10 x1 baking pan
 Bake at 350 for 25-30 minutes
 Let cool then frost

Frosting

3 oz cream cheese, softened
 5 Tbsp. butter, softened
 1 tsp vanilla
 1 ¾ cup powdered sugar
 3 to 4 tsp milk

SPOTLIGHT PHILIP REEDER

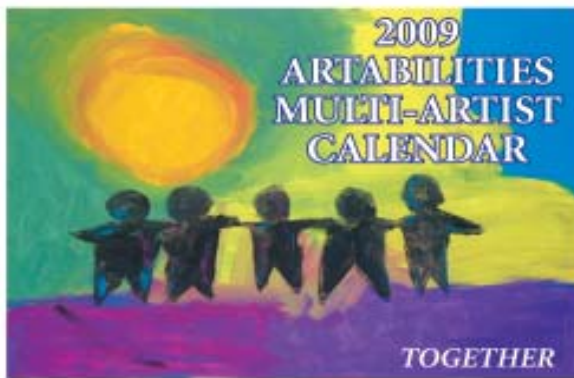
