### **LEE COUNTY DROP-IN CENTER NOW OPEN**

It has been more than two years since the Lee County Stakeholders committee agreed that there was a need in Lee County for a drop-in center. A subcommittee was formed to determine the type of drop-in center needed and to develop a request for proposal. Once approval was given by the Lee County Board of Supervisors the request for proposal was advertised and Hope Haven submitted a proposal. After some review, recommendations, discussions and debates, Hope Haven was offered the contract. The committee was diligent at keeping the idea alive and it is now a reality. The committee consisted of Carole Mertens (8<sup>th</sup> District Patient Advocate), Pat White (DHS Case Management Supervisor), Cathy Campbell (DHS Social Worker II), Barb Clark (Keokuk Area Hospital Psychiatric Unit Supervisor), Jim Posz (Lee County Central Point of Coordination Director) and Penny Logsdon (Lee County Central Point of Coordination Assistant).

The center is open Monday through Friday 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM and is located at 1717 Avenue H in Fort Madison, phone 372-7555. At this time, transportation is available from Keokuk on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. The building and décor is warm and inviting.

There are structured activities offered such as table games, group discussions, movie night as well as special outings, and just time to relax and socialize with others. So far the groups have been small and they have enjoyed fixing meals and snacks together, playing cards, and working on the computer. They have also toured The Fort and played miniature golf. program. Thank you to all who make these activities special for us.

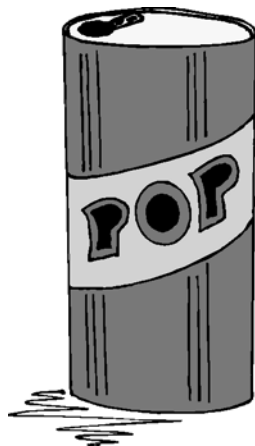
We continue to go to the pool at the Rec Center. This is a lot of fun for all! This is made possible through our donations to purchase a membership.
