We are always looking for new Day Hab activities. Working together to come up with new ideas can sometimes be challenging. The staff here work together to create a wonderful calendar of events.

Back in September we created our own little newspaper called Alternative News. Everyone has a great time interviewing, giving and receiving opinions, weather reporting, and food. We decided to do it again in December and we hand delivered them to all areas of Hope Haven. We got a lot of great feedback and plan on continuing with the newspaper. What are some of the things you have learned?

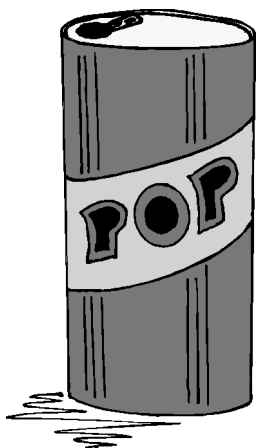
Responsibilities. About badges. Camping in woods, teach survival skills, cooking in pans, making camp fires.

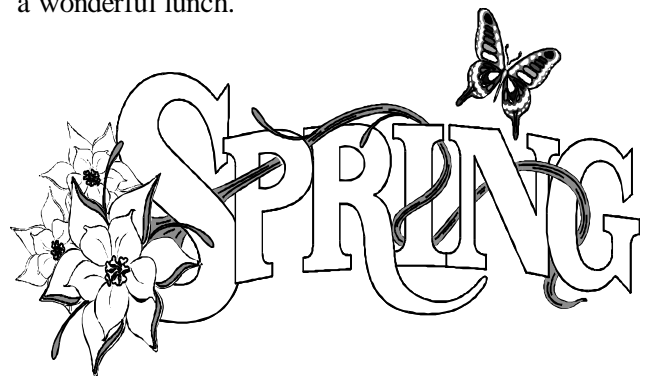

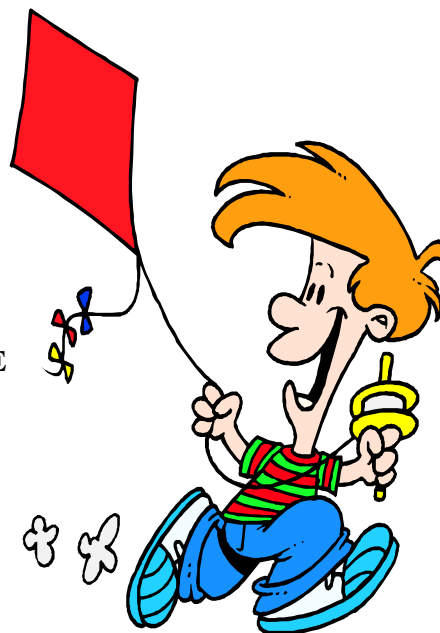
